

## VERIFICATION PROCESS for USERS in the mobile app "OFFLINERY"

Offlinery mainly takes place in the real world. It is therefore essential that we use all means at our disposal to ensure the safety and well-being of all users on our platform.

Users who want to actively address other users ("APPROACH", "BOTH") must undergo additional verification to ensure the security of the addressed users ("BE APPROACHED", "BOTH").

This additional verification includes a verification call, typically 15 minutes, which we carry out manually. In this conversation, the following questions are asked to help us assess the user's personality and intentions.

- 1. "How do you know if someone is interested in you?"
- 2. "How do you usually talk to someone you don't know? Alternatively: How would you address someone?"
- 3. "Tell me a few signals in each other's body language when a person is not interested. How do you know that?"
- 4. "Can you think of a few situations when it might be inappropriate to approach someone?"
- 5. "How would you start the conversation if you approached someone stranger on the street?"
- 6. "What do you think is the most important thing when you speak to someone?"
- 7. "When does no mean no? And when is it okay to keep trying?"
- 8. "How do you react when someone disrespects you?"
- 9. "What unspoken rules do you have for yourself when dealing with others?"
- 10. We reserve the right to ask follow-up questions!

**Important**: If one of our employees suspects that the user does not have good intentions, does not know how to treat other people with respect or is simply not trustworthy - then we reserve the right to refuse access to the app! Of course, you can request a new verification, during which another employee will get an independent opinion.
